- Loss of local employment.
- Parking is inadequate; there is no provision for families with two cars, visitors and trades people.
- Loss of privacy for neighbouring properties via the windows in the living area.
- It would not result in the provision of much needed small dwellings.

ST MARTHA PARISH COUNCIL

It was **AGREED** that the wording on the brass plaque should read: 'Provided by St Martha Parish Council'.

15/101 BUS SHELTER IN CHILWORTH

A discussion took place with regard to the progress with alterating the height to comply with the restrictions as discussed with Surrey County Council (Minutes No: 15/85). The Clerk reported on a quote from Paul Puttock:

- To carefully raise newly constructed bus shelter using forks either end and acro's to support. Insert 200m 100m-block feet under to raise to correct height lower shelter onto feet. Fit anchor straps at corner points and supply and fit skirts all round to cover gap. Total: £3,000.00. The quote includes all plant labour and materials.
- The Clerk reported on the quote from the original contractor:

Materials for the roof: £773.53 Material for the structure: £746.68

Labour on both roof and structure: £1,320.00

Total £2,840.21

Cllr Peake reported that the Parish Council "ordered a new bus shelter like-for-like". Cllr Bunting reported on a discussion with a local builder who suggested that it was the responsibility of the builder to comply with height restrictions.

Cllr Mrs Allen reported that the Parish Council has a moral obligation to the parishioners to comply with the height restrictions.

It was AGREED to write to the original contractor stating the shelter does not conform to highway regulations, and give him the opportunity to rectify the situation.
